mod cons, plus a few extras. The spacious living area features a computer equipped with Photoshop and Lightroom, a digitising tablet, a card reader, a set of ND grad filters and a comprehensive library of photography books and magazines.

While your family amuse themselves in the idyllic surroundings, Alan will take you out on location on three separate photography

workshops during your week's stay. Each session lasts approximately two hours, so there's still plenty of time with the family. All workshops are tailored specifically to the requirements of the individual photographer.

You can opt to visit the many spectacular beaches on the coast or enjoy a dawn or dusk trip on Alan's boat. As you would expect, there are innumerable delights to capture, including windmills, wildlife and spectacular landscapes. All travel and refreshments are included throughout the day.

Heron's Cottage has two bedrooms, one double and one twin, and can comfortably sleep four. You can book for a seven-day holiday all year

round or opt for a three-day short break during autumn and winter. The price for a long weekend, Saturday to Monday, includes two full day workshops.

On arrival all guests are given a welcome pack, which includes all basics to get you started, along with an array of homemade cakes. The Davidson's house and studio is next door so they are close at hand to tend to your every need. There are plenty of walks and sites to explore right on the doorstep as well as the fabulous boardwalk at Barton Broad. You can also arrange to fish from a private mooring if desired. Pubs, shops and restaurants are a short drive away.

The most unique thing

about Norfolk Photography is that every workshop is bespoke. You can have as much tuition as you want, both in the studio or on location. Alternatively, Alan can assist you to realise your own creativity and help you become more comfortable with your camera equipment.

The itinerary is always up to you and is discussed in advance so you get to choose the subject matter most relevant to your interests. What's more, the family will have a great time too! ■
